<u>Impact</u>

The additional sports funding has enabled Airy Hill to widen the activities currently on offer therefore expanding pupils sporting experiences.

Airy Hill School is a very active member of the local Primary Sports Association and performs successfully within the local and wider community at sporting events throughout the year.

Staff are taking advantage of CPD being offered by Caedmon College Whitby as part of the Sports Partnership – this includes Gymnastics, Hockey, Dance and Swimming teaching.

Year 3 and Year 4 are having specialist dance coaching and will be taking part in a Dance Festival at the Spa in March 2017.

We represented Whitby and Ryedale at the North Yorkshire Youth Games in Girls Netball in July 2016 and Sports Hall Athletics in March 2017.

The additional tuition now available will further enhance pupils' success which in turn will have a positive effect on their confidence and general health and wellbeing.
