Cleveland Way Treasure Hunt - Sunday 26 May - 10.30am to 4pm (Drop in any time)

Using one of our GPS units, get out on the Cleveland Way and enjoy a 2-3 mile walk searching for clues in hidden boxes. You pay a charge (per family) for the GPS unit, plus a refundable deposit. Just turn up on the day but allow around two hours to complete the route latest departure time is 2pm. Dogs welcome, but must be kept on a lead. Sorry, routes not accessible by wheelchair.
