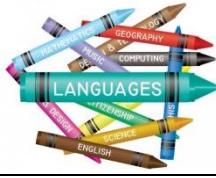

**Optional - wider learning for today...**

Today it's SCIENCE!

The results from the broad bean science experiment we set up in class are in.

Miss Thorpe brought home our broad bean seeds and continued to give them what they needed to see how they would grow. Let's take a look at how they've grown under the different conditions.

**BB Sun and water**

As you can see, this broad bean has begun germination. It has completely broken out of its seed coat and you can see the new plant growing from the seed. It has become a seedling.



**BB Sun no water**

Nothing happened at all to this poor seed



**BB Water no sun**

This broad bean had a tiny crack in the seed coat but nothing else



**BB no sun no water**

Nothing happened at all to this poor seed
