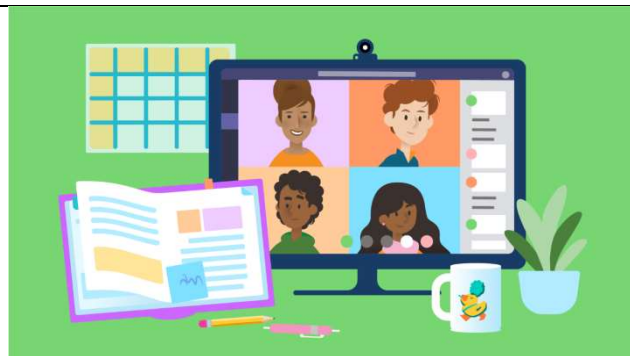


# Home Learning Survey Response Jan 2021
