Arrangements for the end of term



I am writing to inform you about arrangements for the end of term. Given the announcement that the final stage of the government's roadmap has now been delayed, we have made some amendments to our plans.

Sports Day

Children will take part in sports day activities w/c 5th July. Please ensure that children have their PE kits in school every day that week. Unfortunately, we are unable to invite parents in to watch this year, however, we will take plenty of photos to share with you via Facebook.

Beach Visits

Social distancing will not allow our 'beach day' to go ahead in the usual manner. However, children will be visiting the beach before the end of term.

These visits will take place as follows:

- Tuesday 6th July** Years 5 and 6
- Wednesday 7th July** Reception, Year 1 and Year 2
- Thursday 8th July** Years 3 and 4

Children will visit the beach for the morning and return to school in time for lunch. Children will be accompanied by school staff and we will not be inviting parents to join us on this occasion. Please complete and return the consent form on the separate letter.

Transition

Children from Nursery 2 will begin visiting our Reception class in small groups from Monday to begin the transition into school. This will mean that there are a greater number of children mixing during this time. However, we will ensure that accurate records are kept throughout to inform contact tracing in the event of a Covid case within either of these classes.

Transition week is w/c 12th July and children throughout school will spend time with their new class teachers on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings.
